The Big News!

We shared with friends and family just before Christmas that we were in the process of applying with Africa Inland Mission. What we didn't say was what we were applying for, or where. We are so excited to be able to share that the application process is continuing, and we have applied to go to Rwanda! Pete has applied for a position that will see him running a youth camp, focusing on programs that develop leadership skills in young adults, and HIV/AIDS awareness for primary students. My initial role will be in supporting him, settling the kids into Rwandan life, & looking for opportunities where I can be involved.

The Timeline ...

50, where to from here? Our immediate task is to breeze through our 'official' interview with AIM(!) and get medical and psychological clearance. Assuming that happens, we will then spend most of the year raising our support team (prayer and financial) and completing AIM's theological requirements. We will need to complete some home-based orientation (either May or November) and hope to complete Africa-based orientation (in Kenya) next January. We will then move to Rwanda and spend around 6 weeks living with a Rwandan family before settling into our own place. It seems like a mountainous task from this point, but we firmly believe that God is able.
