I had a great time in the States, re-connecting with friends and experiencing the smooth convenience of the western world for a little while. The conference I attended was fantastic, a great couple of days speaking the play therapy 'lingo' and being reminded what a powerful impact it has on the lives of children. I'm really praying that God would show me how I can use Play Therapy here in Rwanda. I also felt very privileged to be involved with the VBS program at Cross Creek Church in Jacksonville, Florida. The kids gave enough for us to provide 4 full scholarships for camp.

We've also just said goodbye to friends visiting from home – grateful for the opportunity to share our lives here with them and catch up with news from home.

We are well and truly in camp mode. Today all the fresh produce is being purchased for the first couple of days at camp (we will purchase more from the local market near camp on Tuesday and Thursday), Pete has also done a couple of runs out to the campsite to take out the non-perishables (beans, sugar, tomato paste, pasta, toilet paper, dishwashing liquid etc). Interviews have been conducted – we have 50 campers and 23 leaders. Tomorrow we and all the leaders head to camp to do the cleaning and prep. Campers will arrive on Monday morning.

Thank you for all of your prayers, on-going support and encouragement, -un fact: This year is Forma'Camp 6. 'Forma' is short for the French word for training - formation
