
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In the blink of an eye 3 months have gone. How does that happen? This time next month we'll be back in Nairobi, on our way to Kigali.

The last 3 months have absolutely flown by. So far we've slept in 18 different beds, driven about 10 000 kilometres (approx. 6200 miles) through 3 states, spoken at 8 churches and done talks for about 11 different groups. And we're not done yet!

It's been an interesting experience — we've loved the chance to catch up with family and friends, but at the same time grieved that the time has been so limited. It's been fantastic to be in a place where we (mostly!) blend in and can enjoy the ease of life in Australia, but at the same time we feel something of a disconnect. We have a little boy who is itching to 'go back home' and a girl who wants to 'stay here at home'. We are, in a very real sense, living between worlds.

We'll keep it short this month, simply because we've shared with so many of you in person (and loved it!). Thank you for the overwhelming support and encouragement that you have given us, not just while we've been home, but for the past 2 years of our ministry in Rwanda. We appreciate you all immensely and while we are sad to be saying goodbye so soon, we are looking forward to sharing more of our Rwandan life and ministry
